

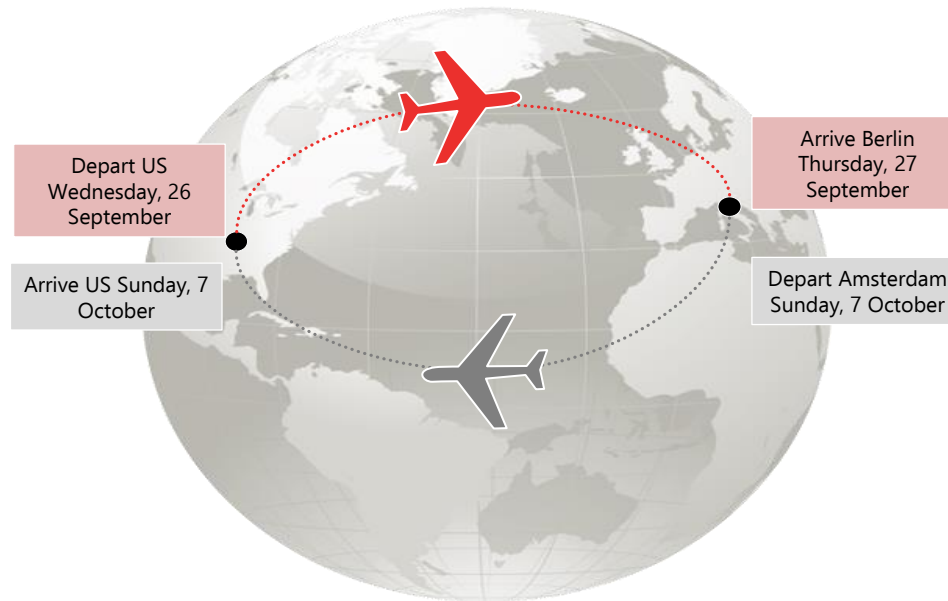


# John Heinricy's Autobahn Tour of Germany

## The Tour Package Does Not Include:

- Airfare to and from Europe
- Shipment of our Corvettes to and from Europe. This cost is transparent and is not marked up and feel free to ship the car yourself
- Green Card insurance (3<sup>RD</sup> party coverage) – This is mandatory in Europe and we will provide it at cost. This will cover us in the event of an accident. It will reimburse for damage done to the other person's car or property but it will not cover damage to our cars (see below)
- The National Corvette Museum Insurance Division will provide us with maritime insurance
- The National Corvette Museum Insurance Division will reimburse for damage done to our Corvettes while in Europe. Green Card will reimburse for damage done to the other party's car and property (see above)
- Emergency medical coverage in Europe is free but for additional personal coverage add travel insurance if needed
- Gasoline and tolls
- Hotel room incidentals and any extra hotel services beyond those contracted
- Heinrocket and Veloce Tours reserve the right to make changes when and as needed

# Shipping & Driving Your Vette in Europe

## The Logistics of Driving your Corvette in Europe

Driving your US-plated Corvette in Europe is unimaginably easy, especially if you let us take care of the details. On the next page we lay out the costs involved but on this page we simply guide you through the process. All you need to do is get the car to an East Coast port of your choice and we will handle the rest. Given the long lead times that we plan into our transport of the cars to Europe (see Appendix for dates) we would want you to deliver your car to the port up to two months before our trip date. The cars will arrive in Bremerhaven, Germany and our port agent will get the cars released from customs and move them on to a car transporter which will deliver them to our hotel in Berlin where they will be waiting for you when you arrive

# Shipping & Driving Your Vette in Europe

## Costs and Logistics in Shipping Corvettes to Europe

All you need to drive your US-plated Corvette in Europe for up to 6 months is 3<sup>rd</sup> Party Green Card insurance (we will procure this for you). When you drop your Corvette off at any US East Coast port remove your license plate(s) and screws and bring them with you to Berlin.

If you drop off your Corvette at Baltimore or Port Newark the direct shipping round trip cost is  $\$665.89 \times 2 = \$1,331.78$  + optional insurance of 1.5% of the car value (\$70k) or  $\$1,050 \times 2 = \$2,100$ . There are also port handling, customs and freight forward fees at both ends of  $\$600 \times 2 = \$1,200$  and \$600 to transport it from Bremerhaven to Berlin and \$270/car/month for the Green Card insurance. Comprehensive coverage is available for an additional cost through the National Corvette Museum. The total cost has been estimated at \$5,500. Below we have attached a sample cost breakdown from the shipper:

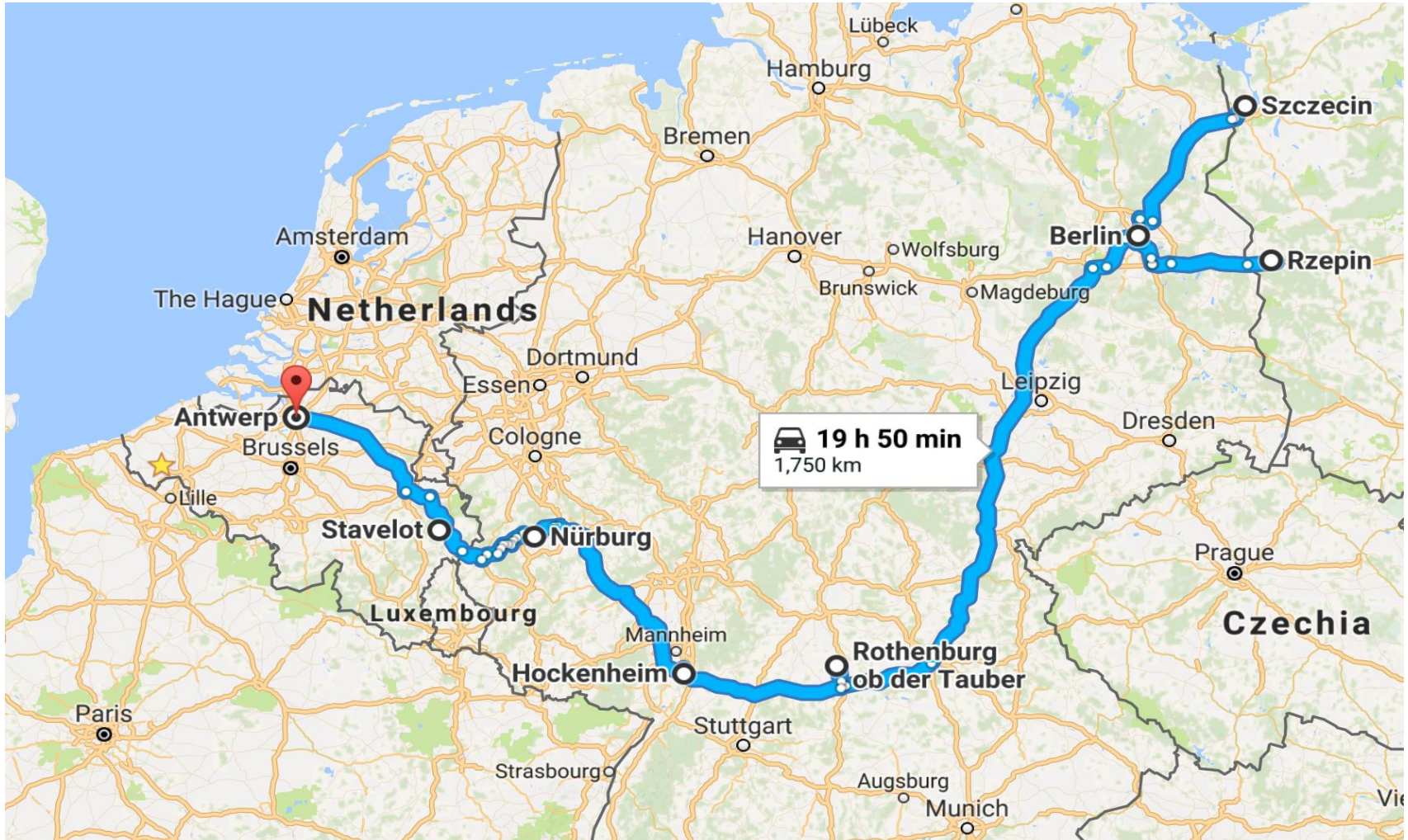

<p><b>Port of Choice</b>            Once you have decided which port you will use we will then provide you with more precise shipping costs. All Vettes need to be portside no later than 5-6 weeks before your arrival date of 27 September, 2018. Ideally your Vette should be at port between the weeks of 23 July and 6 August.            Cars need to be dropped off with ¼ tank or less of gasoline. Remember to remove the license plates and screws and take them with you to put back on when you get to Berlin.
